NEW LAW A new section of law not to be 19 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows: 20 The original or historical routing of State Highway 69 is part 21 of the Historic Jefferson Highway Association Route, which was one 22 of the earliest automobile highways in the United States. The route 23 once ran north to south from Winnipeq, Canada, to New Orleans, 24 Louisiana, and spanned over two thousand three hundred (2,300) miles

1	through seven states. The entire historic route, including the
2	Oklahoma portion, has recently been reidentified by the reformed
3	Jefferson Highway Association organization.
4	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.308 of Title 69, unless
6	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
7	State Highway 69 from the Kansas border to the Texas border
8	shall be designated as the "Historic Jefferson Highway Route". The
9	costs associated with signage required by this section may be
10	provided by private sources, or other categories of available
11	funding, and shall include the cost of the initial erection of signs
12	as well as the cost of potential replacement or reconstruction of
13	signs. Upon receiving adequate funding, the Department of
14	Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
15	upon the highway bearing that name. The permanent markers shall be
16	designed in consultation with the Jefferson Highway Association.
17	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
