A. On and after January 1, 1988, no person may 17 be employed or operate as a security guard, private investigator, 18 security agency, or investigative agency until a license therefor 19 has been issued by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and 20 Training pursuant to the Oklahoma Security Guard and Private 21 Investigator Act. 22 23 B. On or after November 1, 2022, a person employed or operating as an unarmed security guard who has submitted a complete license 24

1	application to the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training
2	and who is employed by a licensed security agency shall have forty-
3	five (45) days from the date of employment to secure a license
4	issued by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training
5	pursuant to the Oklahoma Security Guard and Private Investigator
6	Act. If the application of the person is denied before forty-five
7	(45) days has expired or if the time expires prior to the issuance
8	of a license, the person shall not continue to operate as a security
9	guard until such time as a proper license is issued.
10	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
