A. Cities and towns in this state shall have the right and power to determine what is and what shall constitute a 20 nuisance within their respective corporate limits, and for the 21 protection of the public health, the public parks and the public 22 water supply, shall have such power outside of the corporate limits; 23 24 and wherever it is practical so to do, said the cities and towns

1	shall have the power summarily to abate any such nuisance after
2	notice to the owner, and an opportunity for him to be heard, if this
3	can be given. Any action conducted by critical infrastructure
4	sectors shall not constitute a nuisance when the applicable industry
5	acts in compliance with or acts consistently with government rules,
6	guidelines or laws applicable to their sector.
7	B. For purposes of this section, "critical infrastructure
8	sectors" means any of the critical infrastructure sectors identified
9	by the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) whose
10	assets, systems and networks, whether physical or virtual, are
11	considered so vital to the United States and the state that the
12	sectors' incapacitation or destruction would have a debilitating
13	effect on security, economic security, public health or safety or
14	any combination thereof.
15	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
