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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 5017.7, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 5017.7. A. The <del>Office of the</del> Oklahoma <del>Secretary of</del>
19	State may create and Department of Commerce shall serve as the
20	Oklahoma Chief International Protocol Office and provide a resource
21	for information concerning proper protocol with regard to
22	international diplomats and officials and shall cooperate with other
23	state agencies already engaged in international relations to
24	facilitate and coordinate government resources for optimal

1	leveraging in achieving the common goal of advancing Oklahoma to the
2	forefront of the global community. The Secretary of State An
3	associate with the Oklahoma Department of Commerce may also serve as
4	the official representative of the Governor to ensure that the
5	growing numbers of international officials traveling to Oklahoma are
6	warmly received and enjoy productive visits to the state. When
7	dealing with international visitors of foreign governments, the
8	Secretary of State associate may greet chiefs of state, heads of
9	government and other appropriate functionaries, and may provide
10	support to coordinate, arrange and facilitate meetings and other
11	engagements between the Governor and international leaders.
12	B. The Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall, for the
13	encouragement of international trade opportunities for Oklahoma
14	businesses, encourage and assist the Office of the Oklahoma
15	Secretary of State in private efforts toward the development of
16	interpersonal relationships between citizens of this state and
17	citizens of other nations.
18	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
