14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 51 O.S. 2011, Section 24A.7, as
16	amended by Section 1, Chapter 130, O.S.L. 2014 (51 O.S. Supp. 2020,
17	Section 24A.7), is amended to read as follows:
18	Section 24A.7 A. A public body may keep personnel records
19	confidential:
20	1. Which relate to internal personnel investigations including
21	examination and selection material for employment, hiring,
22	appointment, promotion, demotion, discipline, or resignation; or
23	2. Where disclosure would constitute a clearly unwarranted
24	invasion of personal privacy such as employee evaluations, payroll
