8 An Act relating to children; allowing safety plan
9 monitor of a child in a safety plan to consent to
10 certain examinations of the child; providing for
11 codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-3-104 of Title 10A, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The safety plan monitor of a child who is in a safety plan with
17 the Department of Human Services may, if the parent of the child is
18 unavailable, authorize medical or dental treatment or examinations
19 which are necessary for the well-being of the child.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
