Specifically, the 8 9 Legislature does not intend for the background check conducted by 10 the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to be made public. SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in 11 12 the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 25 of Title 20, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 13 The Judicial Nominating Commission shall promulgate rules to 14 15 promote transparency of the selection process of nominees for judicial office. The rules shall be prominently published on the 16 Judicial Nominating Commission's website. 17 SECTION 3.
