An Act relating to agriculture; requiring Oklahoma Certified Beef labels meet certain definition; requiring enforcement; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-215 of Title 2, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Persons shall not label any bovine product as Oklahoma Certified Beef unless it meets the definition of Oklahoma certified beef as defined in Section 6-214 of Title 2 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry shall enforce this requirement pursuant to Section 2-18 of Title 2 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.

1       SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
2 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
