An Act relating to prisons and reformatories; amending 57 O.S. 2021, Section 509, which relates to the Oklahoma Corrections Act of 1967; updating list of penal institutions; adding facilities; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2021, Section 509, is amended to read as follows:

Section 509. A. The Oklahoma Department of Corrections is authorized to maintain the following facilities in Oklahoma:

1. Oklahoma State Penitentiary shall be located at in McAlester
~~in Pittsburg County, State of Oklahoma; and the~~

2. Oklahoma State Reformatory shall be located at in Granite in Greer County, State of Oklahoma; and the

3 Oklahoma City Community Corrections Center in Oklahoma City;

4. Lexington Assessment and Reception Center shall be located at in Lexington in Cleveland County, State of Oklahoma; and the

1 5. Jackie Brannon Correctional Center shall be located at in
2 McAlester in Pittsburg County, State of Oklahoma; and the

3 6. Joseph Harp Correctional Center shall be located at in
4 Lexington in Cleveland County, State of Oklahoma; and the

5 7. Howard C. McLeod Correctional Center shall be located at
6 Farris in Atoka County, State of Oklahoma; and the

7 8. Mack H. Alford Correctional Center shall be located at in
8 Stringtown in Atoka County, State of Oklahoma; and the

9 9. Jim E. Hamilton Correctional Center shall be located at in
10 Hodgen in LeFlore County, State of Oklahoma; and the

11 10. Mabel Bassett Correctional Center shall be located at in
12 McLoud, in Pottawatomie County, State of Oklahoma; and the

13 11. R.B. "Dick" Conner Correctional Center shall be located at
14 in Hominy in Osage County, State of Oklahoma; and the

15 12. James Crabtree Correctional Center shall be located at in
16 Helena in Alfalfa County, State of Oklahoma; and the

17 13. Jess Dunn Correctional Center shall be located at in Taft
18 in Muskogee County, State of Oklahoma; and the

19 14. Northeast Oklahoma Correctional Center shall be located at
20 in Vinita in Craig County, State of Oklahoma; and the

21 15. North Fork Correctional Center in Sayre;

22 16. John Lilley Correctional Center shall be located at in
23 Boley in Okfuskee County, State of Oklahoma; and the William S. Key

1 Correctional Center shall be located at Fort Supply in Woodward
2 County, State of Oklahoma; and the

3 17. Dr. Eddie Walter Warrior Correctional Center shall be
4 located at in Taft in Muskogee County, State of Oklahoma; and the

5 18. Clara Waters and Kate Barnard Community Corrections Centers
6 shall be located at Center in Oklahoma City in Oklahoma County,
7 State of Oklahoma; and the

8 19. Lawton Community Corrections Center shall be located at in
9 Lawton in Comanche County, State of Oklahoma; and the

10 20. Enid Community Corrections Center shall be located at in
11 Enid in Garfield County, State of Oklahoma; and the

12 21. Union City Community Corrections Center shall be located at
13 in Union City in Canadian County, State of Oklahoma; and the

14 22. Charles E. "Bill" Johnson Correctional Center shall be
15 located east of in Alva in Woods County, State of Oklahoma; and the
16 Washita Valley Correctional Center shall be located at Pauls Valley
17 in Garvin County, State of Oklahoma; and said institutions and
18 community corrections centers are hereby established within the
19 Department. Said.

20 B. The Department shall be the legal successor of and, except
21 as otherwise provided in the Oklahoma Corrections Act of 1967, shall
22 have the powers and duties vested by law in the Office of Management
23 and Enterprise Services in all matters relating to penal
24 institutions, heretofore or hereafter established by the Department,

1 which institutions and community corrections centers shall be under
2 the administrative direction and control of the Department.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
