23	title does not include the Oklahoma Tax Commission Service Oklahoma.
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1 Any motor license agent fees collected by a state agency shall be 2 deposited into the General Revenue Fund. В. Motor license agents Licensed operators selected as provided 3 in subsection A of this section shall receive all fees provided by 4 5 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act; provided, the amount of fees remitted to the motor license agent for each online transaction processed by the motor license agent through any online 7 system shall be reduced by One Dollar and fifty-six cents (\$1.56). 9 C. The selection step required pursuant to subsection A of this section shall be installed and operational no later than January 1, 10 2021. 11 12 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval. 15 SECTION 3.
