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L1	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
L2	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1-104, is
L3	amended to read as follows:
L 4	Section 1-104. A. A bicycle is a device upon which any person
L 5	or persons may ride, propelled solely by human power through a belt,
L 6	chain, or gears, and having two or more wheels, excluding mopeds.
L7	B. An electric-assisted bicycle is any bicycle with:
L 8	1. Two or three wheels; and
L 9	2. Fully operative pedals for human propulsion and equipped
20	with an electric motor with a power output of not more than seven
21	hundred fifty (750) watts that meets the requirements of one of the
22	following three classes:
23	a. "Class 1 electric-assisted bicycle" shall mean an
> Д	electric-assisted bicycle equipped with a motor that

provides assistance only when the rider is pedaling,

and that ceases to provide assistance when the bicycle

reaches the speed of twenty (20) miles per hour,

- b. "Class 2 electric-assisted bicycle" shall mean an electric-assisted bicycle equipped with a motor that may be used exclusively to propel the bicycle, and that is not capable of providing assistance when the bicycle reaches the speed of twenty (20) miles per hour, and
- c. "Class 3 electric-assisted bicycle" shall mean an electric-assisted bicycle equipped with a motor that provides assistance only when the rider is pedaling, and that ceases to provide assistance when the bicycle reaches the speed of twenty-eight (28) miles per hour.

An electric-assisted bicycle shall meet the manufacturing and equipment requirements adopted by the Consumer Product Safety

Commission for bicycles and shall operate in such a manner that the electric motor disengages or ceases to function when the rider stops pedaling or the brakes are applied.

- C. A motorized bicycle is any bicycle having:
- 1. Fully operative pedals for propulsion by human power;
- 22 2. A power drive system that functions directly or
 23 automatically without clutching or shifting by the operator after
 24 the drive system is engaged; and

1	3. A combustion engine with a piston or rotor displacement of
2	eighty (80 cu cm) cubic centimeters <u>(80 cc)</u> or less, regardless of
3	the number of chambers in the engine, which is capable of propelling
4	the bicycle at a maximum design speed of not more than thirty-five
5	(35) miles per hour on level ground.

- D. As used in this title, the term "bicycle" shall include tricycles, quadcycles, or similar human-powered devices, electricassisted bicycles, and motorized bicycles unless otherwise specifically indicated.
- SECTION 2. 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1-133.3, is 10 AMENDATORY amended to read as follows: 11
- Section 1-133.3 Motorized scooter. 12
 - A. A "motorized scooter" is any vehicle having:
 - Not more than three wheels in contact with the ground;
 - 2. Handlebars and a foot support or seat for the use of the operator;
 - 3. A power source that is capable of propelling the vehicle at a maximum design speed of not more than twenty-five (25) miles per hour on level ground, and.
 - if the power source is a combustion engine, has a piston or rotor displacement of thirty-five cubic centimeters (35 cu cm) (35 cc) or less regardless of the number of chambers in the power source,

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1	b. if the power source is electric, has a power output of
2	not more than one thousand (1,000) watts.
3	B. For purposes of this section, an electric personal assistive
4	mobility device, as defined in Section 1-114A of this title,
5	bicycle, electric-assisted bicycle, or motorized bicycle, as defined
6	in Section 1-104 of this title, shall not be considered a motorized
7	scooter.
8	C. A motorized scooter shall not be required to be registered
9	under the laws of this state. The operator of a motorized scooter
10	shall not be required to possess a driver license or to comply with
11	the vehicle insurance or financial responsibility laws of this
12	state.
13	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
