10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
11	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.364 of Title 69, unless
13	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
14	The section of State Highway 56 beginning at the intersection of
15	Dripping Springs Road extending easterly to the intersection of
16	Madison Avenue on the west side of the city of Okmulgee in Okmulgee
17	County shall be designated as the "Senator Roger Ballenger Memorial
18	Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
19	permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.
20	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.365 of Title 69, unless
22	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
23	The section of U.S. Highway 281 beginning at the intersection of
24	N2400 Road extending approximately five (5) miles east then north to

- 2 | be designated as the "Judge Dean Linder Memorial Highway". The
- 3 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
- 4 | bearing that name to be placed on the highway.
- 5 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
- 6 | in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.366 of Title 69, unless
- 7 | there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- 8 The section of U.S. Highway 64 beginning at the northern
- 9 | municipal limits of Cherokee extending north to the intersection of
- 10 | State Highway 11 in Alfalfa County shall be designated as the "Loyd
- 11 | Stout Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
- 12 | suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
- 13 highway.
- 14 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
- 15 | in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.367 of Title 69, unless
- 16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- 17 The bridge crossing over the Turner Turnpike located on State
- 18 | Highway 18 at the north edge of Chandler in Lincoln County shall be
- 19 designated as the "SGT Ronald Crews Bridge". The Department of
- 20 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
- 21 name to be placed on the bridge.
- 22 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
- 23 | in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.368 of Title 69, unless
- 24 | there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The section of U.S. Highway 59 in Stilwell beginning on the north side of the State Highway 100 intersection extending north to 2 the intersection of State Highway 51 East in Adair County shall be 3 designated as the "Vernus W. Bales Memorial Highway". 4 5 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway. 6 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.369 of Title 69, unless 9 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 10 The sections of U.S. Highways 60 Business and 60 extending between the Tonkawa and Ponca City National Guard armories in Kay 11 County shall be designated as the "MAJ Kerry "WarDog 6" Trent and 12 SSG Michael D. Ward Memorial Trail". The Department of 13 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that 14 name to be placed on the highways. 15 A new section of law to be codified SECTION 7. NEW LAW 16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.370 of Title 69, unless 17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 18 The bridge crossing over Coal Creek on U.S. Highway 59 north of 19 Panama in LeFlore County shall be designated as the "SGT Billy 20 Rodgers Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall 21 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on 22 the bridge. 23

1 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.371 of Title 69, unless 2 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 3 The section of State Highway 71 beginning at the intersection of 4 5 State Highway 9 in Haskell County extending north six (6) miles to the intersection of S4306 Road in McIntosh County shall be 6 designated as the "Harold Haltom Memorial Highway". The Department 7 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing 8 9 that name to be placed on the highway. A new section of law to be codified 10 SECTION 9. NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.372 of Title 69, unless 11 12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The bridge on U.S. Highway 177 crossing over the Salt Fork 13 Arkansas River south of Ponca City at the Kay County-Noble County 14 line shall be designated as the "Jerry Evans Memorial Bridge". 15 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers 16 bearing that name to be placed on the bridge. 17 A new section of law to be codified SECTION 10. NEW LAW 18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.373 of Title 69, unless 19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 20 The section of State Highway 18 beginning at the intersection of 21 State Highway 33 in Cushing extending north two miles in Payne 22 County shall be designated as the "WWII Veteran Roy J. "Junior" 23

Herring Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall

cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

- in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.374 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- The intersection of U.S. Highway 177 and State Highway 105 in Lincoln County shall be designated as the "Womack Four Corners".

  The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highways.
  - SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.375 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
  - The section of State Highway 5 beginning at the intersection of State Highway 54 extending east to the intersection of State Highway 36 in Tillman County shall be designated as the "Edgar L. Hamm Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.
- SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.376 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- The section of State Highway 49 beginning at the Interstate 44 interchange extending west to the intersection of State Highway 58 near Medicine Park in Comanche County shall be designated as the

- 1 "Edward A. Hilliary, Jr. "Junior" Memorial Highway". The Department
- 2 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing
- 3 that name to be placed on the highway.
- 4 SECTION 14. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
- 5 | in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.377 of Title 69, unless
- 6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- 7 The section of State Highway 76 beginning at the intersection of
- 8 | Getty Road extending north and east along State Highway 7 to the
- 9 intersection of Delta Road in Carter County shall be designated as
- 10 | the "Okla. Horse Racing Hall of Fame Inductees Carl and Rozella
- 11 | Pevehouse Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
- 12 | suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
- 13 | highway.
- 14 SECTION 15. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1692, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 Section 1692. The portion of State Highway 49 between
- 17 | Interstate 44 and beginning at the intersection of State Highway 58
- 18 | extending west to the Wichita Mountains Wildlife Refuge shall be
- 19 designated as the "Medicine Park Trail". The Department of
- 20 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
- 21 upon the portion of highway bearing that designation.
- 22 SECTION 16. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1698.310,
- 23 is amended to read as follows:

1 Section 1698.310 The bridge over the Cimarron River on U.S. Highway 15 287 approximately thirteen (13) miles north of Boise City 2 shall be designated as the "Private Robert "Bob" Clark Memorial 3 Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable 4 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge. 5 SECTION 17. 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1698.334, 6 AMENDATORY is amended to read as follows: 7 Section 1698.334 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, 8 9 the section of State Highway 28A in Rogers County beginning at the 10 intersection of State Highway 66 near the Town of Foyil, extending 11 east to the intersection of State Highway 28, then continuing east 12 to the Interstate 44 in Rogers County interchange in Mayes County shall be designated as the "CSM Junior H. Honeycutt Memorial 13 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable Highway". 14 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway. 15 SECTION 18. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1698.351, 16 is amended to read as follows: 17 Section 1698.351 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, 18 the section of U.S. Highway 77 beginning at the intersection of 19 Broadway Avenue in Ardmore extending north to the intersection of 20 State Highway 142 in Carter County shall be designated as the "Mayor 21 Martin Dyer Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation 22 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to the be 23 24 placed on the highway.

2	is amended to read as follows:
3	Section 1698.354 The section of U.S. Highway 62 beginning at
4	the intersection of N3990 Road extending east through the town of
5	Morris to the intersection of N 4030 Road in Okmulgee County shall
6	be designated as the " <u>USS Arizona Survivor</u> Lonnie D. Cook Memorial
7	Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
8	permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.
9	SECTION 20. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
