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8	An Act relating to teachers; amending 70 O.S. 2021, Section 6-204.1, which relates to the Education
9	Leadership Oklahoma Act; adding definitions; amending 70 O.S. 2021, Section 6-212, which relates to a
10	micro-credential program for teachers; restricting program eligibility to certified teachers; including
11	certain micro-credential stacks, endorsements, and micro-credentials in program; modifying how awarded
12	micro-credentials in program, modifying new dwarded micro-credentials may be used; authorizing rule promulgation to implement program; and providing an
13	effective date.
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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 6-204.1, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 6-204.1 For purposes of the Education Leadership
19	Oklahoma Act:
20	1. "Salary bonus" means additional monies granted to eligible
21	teachers as provided for in subsection I of Section 6-204.2 of this
22	title maintaining National Board certification;
23	2. "Salary increment" means the National Board certification

salary category as set forth in Section  $\frac{3}{18-114.14}$  of this  $\frac{1}{18-114.14}$ 

- 1 title which is granted to eligible teachers as provided for in
  2 subsection I of Section 6-204.2 of this title maintaining National
  3 Board certification;
  - 3. "Certification" means National Board certification;

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- 4. "Commission" means the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation;
- 5. "National Board" means the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards;
- 6. "National Board certification" means National Board certification as provided by the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards; and
- 7. "Teacher" means a classroom teacher, counselor, or librarian employed by a public school district on a full-time basis;
  - 8. "Digital badge" means a web-based artifact that contains metadata which documents a teacher's completion of a specific skill or set of skills and can be shared and verified electronically;
  - 9. "Endorsement" means a certification earned by a certified

    teacher who completes a micro-credential stack which, where

    applicable, may be used in lieu of the subject area competency

    examination required by Section 6-187 of this title for subject

    areas that are substantially equal to the content covered in a

    stack;
- 23 <u>10. "Micro-credential" means a postsecondary credential to</u>
  24 <u>support teacher instruction comprised of a coherent set of</u>

1	measurable activities or projects that provide specific career
2	critical skills, competencies, and knowledge that can be readily
3	implemented in a school setting. Micro-credentials may be used to
4	meet the professional development program requirements established
5	in Section 6-194 of this title; and
6	11. "Micro-credential stack" or "stack" means a series of
7	micro-credentials that collectively address a broad range of
8	content-area knowledge or skills and which may be completed to earn
9	an endorsement.
10	SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 6-212, is
11	amended to read as follows:
12	Section 6-212. A. The State Department of Education <del>in</del>
13	coordination with the Commission for Educational Quality and
14	Accountability shall establish a micro-credential program within one
15	hundred twenty (120) days after the effective date of this act for
16	the purpose of permitting any <del>teacher candidate or</del> <u>certified</u> teacher
17	who holds a certificate to teach to complete additional coursework
18	and earn micro-credentials in science, technology, engineering and
19	mathematics (STEM) endorsement areas including computer science.
20	The micro-credential program shall include, but is not limited to:
21	1. Micro-credential stacks supporting science, technology,
22	engineering, and mathematics (STEM) integration, provided any
23	endorsements earned upon completion shall not substitute for the

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1	subject area competency examinations in science, technology,
2	engineering, and mathematics;
3	2. Endorsements for Elementary Computer Science and Secondary
4	Computer Science; and
5	3. A micro-credential for the purpose of permitting any teacher
6	to complete additional coursework to earn a micro-credential in
7	dyslexia.
8	B. The State Department of Education and, in consultation with
9	the Commission for Educational Quality and Accountability and the
LO	Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, shall convene a working
L1	group including pertinent education stakeholders to determine how if
L2	any micro-credential awarded pursuant to any micro-credential
L3	program established pursuant to subsection A of this section will
L 4	may be used and such uses shall include:
15	1. To award add-on endorsements to teachers in STEM endorsement
L6	areas including computer science;
L7	<del>2. In</del> <u>in</u> lieu of the subject area competency examination
L8	required by Section 6-187 of <del>Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes</del> this
L9	title; and
20	3. To meet the professional development program requirements
21	established in Section 6-194 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

C. Any course offered through a micro-credential program

established pursuant to subsection A of this section may be offered

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1	in person, online or in a blended format of in-person and online
2	instruction.
3	D. The State Board of Education, in consultation with the
4	Commission for Educational Quality and Accountability and the
5	Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, shall promulgate rules
6	as necessary to implement the micro-credential program and ensure
7	that rigor and content adequately prepares teachers to provide
8	quality instruction.
9	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
