18	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

21	A. There is hereby created until November 30, 2023, a task

3 B. The task force shall be comprised of nine (9) members to be 4 appointed as follows:

5 1. Two members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the 6 Senate, one of whom shall be a teacher employed by a public school 7 district located in a county with a population of less than seventy 8 thousand (70,000) according to the latest Federal Decennial Census 9 and one of whom shall be a teacher employed by a public school 10 district located in a county with a population of more than seventy 11 thousand (70,000) according to the latest Federal Decennial Census;

12 2. Two members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, one of whom shall be a teacher employed by a public 13 school district located in a county with a population of less than 14 seventy thousand (70,000) according to the latest Federal Decennial 15 Census and one of whom shall be a teacher employed by a public 16 school district located in a county with a population of more than 17 seventy thousand (70,000) according to the latest Federal Decennial 18 Census; 19

One member appointed by the Governor, who shall be a teacher
 employed by a public school district in this state;

4. One member appointed by the Superintendent of Public
Instruction, who shall be a current or former Oklahoma Teacher of
the Year and who shall serve as chair of the task force;

5. One member appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the
 Senate, who shall be a superintendent employed by a public school
 district in this state and who shall serve as vice chair of the task
 force;

6. One member appointed by the Speaker of the House of
Representatives, who shall be a superintendent employed by a public
school district in this state; and

8 7. One member appointed by the Governor, who shall be a
9 superintendent employed by a public school district in this state.
10 C. Appointments to the task force shall be made within thirty
11 (30) days after the effective date of this act. The task force
12 shall conduct an organizational meeting not later than September 1,

D. A quorum of the task force shall be required to approve any
final action of the task force. For purposes of this section, five
members shall constitute a quorum.

E. The task force may meet as often as may be required toperform the duties imposed upon it.

F. Task force members may participate via videoconference if
they are visible and audible to each other through a video monitor.
G. Members of the task force shall receive no compensation or
