13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1201 of Title 60, unless there
15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A real estate contract for the sale, conveyance, or exchange of
17	real property, option to purchase real property, or a lease with an
18	option to purchase real property may include a contingency, not to
19	exceed one hundred eighty (180) days, for the purposes of securing
20	required permits, lot changes, zoning changes, and any other land
21	use approvals necessary to use and operate the real property.
22	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
