16 7. The share of Oklahoma college and university graduates 17 working in an occupation that does not require a bachelor's degree;

8. The average starting salary for individuals graduating from
 an institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education;
 and

9. The average starting salary for individuals graduating froma technology center school in this state.

D. To compile the information required by subsection C of thissection, the State Department of Education may collaborate with the

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Oklahoma Department of Commerce, the Oklahoma Department of Career
 and Technology Education, and the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher
 Education. The State Department of Education may enter into a
 memorandum of understanding with a state agency or division to
 collect information required by subsection C of this section.

E. The State Department of Education shall post on its website
no later than October 15 of each year the information collected
pursuant to subsection C of this section so that it is accessible to
every public high school in this state for distribution to students
by school counselors.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022. SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
