AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1963, is 17 amended to read as follows: 18 Section 1963. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a 19 revolving fund to be designated the "Highway Construction Materials 20 Technician Certification Board Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a 21 continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall 22 consist of all monies received by the Board for deposit in the fund. 23

All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby

1	appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Board for the
2	purpose of conducting training and or certification of individuals
3	seeking to become registered as a highway construction materials
4	technician examination and the execution of the powers and duties of
5	the Board as set forth in this act. Expenditures from the fund
6	shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against
7	claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of
8	Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.
9	SECTION 2. REPEALER 69 O.S. 2021, Sections 1951, 1952,
10	1953, 1954, 1955, 1956, 1957, 1958, 1959, 1960, 1961, 1962, and
11	1964, are hereby repealed.
12	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
