20	employee of such person, firm, association or corporation as may be
21	a party to the proceeding, action or cause pending before or being

tried by said Commission; provided, that if otherwise relevant and

admissible, reports of audit, balance sheets, operating statements

and financial exhibits and schedules prepared by employees of said
