L2	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 3-118, is

L5	each county may change the boundaries of, abolish or consolidate any
L 6	precinct, subject to the limitations provided by law, by observing
L7	the following procedure:
L8	1. No precinct shall be created, divided, abolished or
L 9	consolidated, or any boundary otherwise changed between January 1 of
20	any year which last digit is nine and December 31 of any year which
21	last digit is zero; and
22	2. The secretary of a county election board shall only change a
23	precinct by dividing or consolidating a precinct into two or more

precincts in a manner which will conform to designated census

- 3 or impede a voter's ability to vote, or to accomplish

- 5 | Such changes shall conform to the requirements contained in Sections
- 6 3-115 and 3-116 of this title.
- 7 | 3. Changes may not become effective until notices of such
- 8 changes have been posted and mailed as provided in this paragraph
- 9 for thirty (30) days. One notice shall be posted at the door of the
- 10 polling place for the affected precinct, one notice posted at the
- 11 door of the county courthouse and one notice shall be mailed to the
- 12 | State Election Board.
- 13 | 4. The registration of each registered voter affected by such
- 14 change shall be transferred as provided by law by the secretary of
- 15 | the county election board without any request from the voter.
- 16 5. Each registered voter whose registration is transferred as
- 17 hereinbefore provided shall be notified of such transfer in writing
- 18 by the secretary of the county election board. At the same time,
- 19 the voter shall be issued a new voter identification card and shall
- 20 be instructed to destroy his or her former voter identification
- 21 card.
- 22 | SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
- 23 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
