| 15 | SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 14 O.S. 2021, Section 80.8, is  |

| 17 | Section 80.8. To file as a candidate for the State Senate in  |
| 18 | any senatorial district, a person must have been a registered voter                                 |
| 19 | in the district and a resident residing within such district for the                                |
| 20 | six-month period immediately preceding the first day of the filing                                  |
| 21 | period as provided by law. <del>Provided, however, to file as a</del>                               |
| 22 | candidate for the Senate in any Senate district in 2022, a person                                   |
| 23 | must have been a registered voter and a resident residing in such                                   |
| 24 | district no later than December 31, 2021. Any member of the Senate                                  |
