L3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
L 4	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1000.21, as
L5	amended by Section 2, Chapter 223, O.S.L. 2014 (59 O.S. Supp. 2020,
L 6	Section 1000.21), is amended to read as follows:
L7	Section 1000.21. A. 1. There is hereby created the Oklahoma
L8	Uniform Building Code Commission within the Construction Industries
L9	Board which shall consist of eleven (11) thirteen (13) members, nine
20	<u>eleven</u> of whom shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice
21	and consent of the Senate as follows:
22	a. one member who is a general contractor from a
23	statewide organization that represents residential
24	construction,

2		statewide organization that represents commercial
3		construction,
4	С.	one member who is a contractor from a statewide
5		organization that represents electrical contractors,
6	d.	one member who is a contractor from a statewide

9		organization that represents heating and cooling
10		contractors,
11	f.	one member who is a licensed electrical engineer from

23		employed by a political subdivision,

5	knowledge of building codes and experience in property

8	a state-recognized professional engineering firm.
9	2. The members shall be appointed for staggered terms of four
L O	(4) years, beginning July 1, 2009. The initial appointment of the
L1	members added by this act shall be made within ninety (90) days of
L2	the effective date of this act. A full term of office for purposes
L3	of determining term limits provided in subsection C of this section
L 4	shall be the completion of a full four-year term of appointment.
L5	B. The remaining two members of the Commission shall be the
16	State Fire Marshal, or a designee, and an appointee of the
L7	Construction Industries Board.
L8	C. Appointed members shall continue in office until a successor
L 9	is appointed by the Governor, notwithstanding the term limitations.
20	No appointed member shall serve more than two consecutive full four-
21	year terms; provided, such a member shall be eligible to serve until
22	a successor is appointed, and such member may be reappointed after a

two-year absence from the Commission. The Governor shall fill all

vacancies and unexpired terms in the same manner as the original

1	appointment of the member whose position is to be filled. No
2	initial appointment to a term of less than four (4) years or any
3	partial-term appointment to fill a vacancy or unexpired term of
4	another member shall be counted for purposes of determining term
5	limits. An appointed member may be removed by the Governor for
6	cause.
7	D. Whenever a member of the Commission is absent from more than
8	one-half $(1/2)$ of all meetings of the governing body, regular and
9	special, held within any period of twelve (12) consecutive months,
10	the member shall thereupon cease to hold office by operation of law.
11	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.
12	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
14	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
