BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

For the purposes of a federal Medicaid supplemental payment program for nonstate government owned nursing facilities and hospitals, "nonstate government owned" means owned by a government other than the state including but not limited to:

1. A board of control created by and charged by a board of county commissioners with the management and control of a county hospital as provided by Section 789 of Title 19 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 2. A public trust or other organization that is created by a
2 county under Section 176 of Title 60 of the Oklahoma Statutes and is
3 under lease with a board of county commissioners for the operation
4 of a county hospital as provided by Section 789 of Title 19 of the
5 Oklahoma Statutes;

6 3. A municipal governing body that has established and
7 maintains a municipal hospital as provided by Section 30-101 of
8 Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

9 4. A board of control created by and charged by a municipal
10 governing body with the management and control of a municipal
11 hospital as provided by Section 30-102 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma
12 Statutes; and

13 5. Any municipal or governmental body other than the state
14 authorized to operate a health care facility including a hospital or
15 nursing facility.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

17 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
18 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
