vessel beverage license held by a railroad described in 49 U.S.C.,

D. An applicant may apply for and receive both an on-premisesbeer and wine license and a caterer license.

8 E. All licenses, except as otherwise provided, shall be valid
9 for one (1) year from date of issuance unless revoked or
10 surrendered. Provided, all employee licenses shall be valid for two
11 (2) years.

12 F. The holder of a license, issued by the ABLE Commission, for a bottle club located in a county of this state where the sale of 13 alcoholic beverages by the individual drink for on-premises 14 consumption has been authorized, may exchange the bottle club 15 license for a mixed beverage license or an on-premises beer and wine 16 license and operate the licensed premises as a mixed beverage 17 establishment or an on-premises beer and wine establishment subject 18 to the provisions of the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Control Act. 19 There shall be no additional fee for such exchange and the mixed 20 beverage license or on-premises beer and wine license issued shall 21 expire one (1) year from the date of issuance of the original bottle 22 club license. 23
