NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 85.49 of Title 74, unless there 10 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 11 A. Beginning on July 1, 2024, five percent (5%) of all state 12 contracts shall be awarded to businesses that have been in operation 13 for less than five (5) years. 14 B. For competitive bids submitted to the state pursuant to the 15 Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act or pursuant to the Public 16 Competitive Bidding Act of 1974 by eligible new corporations, the 17 State Purchasing Director shall prepare and implement a bid-18 preference program. The program shall require that, if the 19 percentage of such funds expended on eligible new corporations is 20 less than ten percent (10%), a percentage shall be added to the 21 price of the lowest bid and if the eligible new corporation submits 22 a bid that falls below the lowest bid plus the percentage, it shall 23 receive the contract. As used in this subsection, "eligible new 24

corporation" means a corporation validly licensed as provided in the applicable laws of this state on and after the effective date of this act. SECTION 2.
