10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
11	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 1750.10A, is
12	amended to read as follows:
13	Section 1750.10A. A. An armed security guard shall be
14	authorized to carry a rifle during the performance of his or her
15	duties.
16	B. The firearm training for armed security guards may include
17	the reduction targets for weapons fired at fifty (50) feet to
18	simulate weapons fired at seventy-five (75) feet in indoor ranges.
19	All indoor ranges for this training shall have a minimum of three
20	firing lanes and be approved by the Council on Law Enforcement
21	Education and Training.
22	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
