## 1 SENATE FLOOR VERSION February 9, 2021 2 3 SENATE BILL NO. 238 By: Pemberton of the Senate 4 and 5 Nollan of the House 6 7 8 An Act relating to schools; creating a task force to study and make recommendations regarding a 9 requirement for high school students to complete certain application prior to graduation; providing expiration date; providing for membership; providing 10 for naming of co-chairs; requiring appointments by certain date; requiring organizational meeting by 11 certain date; specifying quorum; providing for 12 frequency of meetings; subjecting meetings to the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act; prohibiting compensation or travel reimbursement for members; providing for 13 staff support; requiring submission of certain report by certain date; providing for codification; 14 providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency. 15 16 17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: 18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-112 of Title 70, unless there 20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 21 There is hereby created until December 31, 2021, a task 22 force to study whether to require high school students to complete 23

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1 the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as a prerequisite for high school graduation.

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- 3 The task force shall be comprised of nine (9) members to be В. appointed as follows:
- 5 The State Superintendent of Public Instruction or a designee; 6
  - 2. The Chancellor of Higher Education or a designee;
  - The Director of the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education or a designee;
- 10 4. One member who represents an institution within The Oklahoma 11 State System of Higher Education, appointed by the Chancellor of 12 Higher Education;
  - 5. One member who represents a school district with an average daily membership (ADM) of more than nine thousand (9,000), appointed by the State Superintendent of Public Instruction;
    - 6. One member who represents a school district with an ADM of more than one thousand five hundred (1,500) but less than nine thousand (9,000), appointed by the State Superintendent of Public Instruction:
- 7. One member who represents a school district with an ADM of 20 less than one thousand five hundred (1,500), appointed by the State 21 Superintendent of Public Instruction; 22
- 8. One member of the Senate, appointed by the President Pro 23 Tempore of the Senate; and 24

- 9. One member of the House of Representatives, appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
  - C. The co-chairs of the task force shall be the member of the Senate and the member of the House of Representatives.

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- D. Appointments to the task force shall be made within thirty (30) days after the effective date of this act. The task force shall conduct an organizational meeting not later than September 1, 2021.
- 9 E. A quorum of the task force shall be required to approve any
  10 final action of the task force. For purposes of this section, five
  11 members shall constitute a quorum.
- F. The task force may meet as often as may be required to perform the duties imposed upon it.
- G. The meetings of the task force shall be subject to the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act.
  - H. Members of the task force shall receive no compensation or travel reimbursement.
- I. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and the

  Senate shall provide staff and administrative support for the task

  force.
- J. The task force shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations by December 31, 2021, to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021. SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
