L5	No insurer licensed to do business in this state that issues
L 6	policies of individual or group accident and health insurance, as
L7	defined in Section 703 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall
L 8	unfairly discriminate against an insured or applicant for insurance
L 9	based solely on the vaccination or immunity status of the insured

21	1. Denying, canceling or failing to renew an accident and
22	health insurance policy;
23	2. Basing renewal rates, premiums, policy fees or rates charged

for any policy or contract of accident or health insurance; or

1	3. Failing to compensate or compensating at a lower rate any
2	health care provider, as defined in Section 1219.6 of Title 36 of
3	the Oklahoma Statutes, for a covered service.
4	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
