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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 1750.4, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 1750.4. A. On and after January 1, 1988, no person may
16	be employed or operate as a security guard, private investigator,
17	security agency, or investigative agency until a license therefor
18	has been issued by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
19	Training pursuant to the Oklahoma Security Guard and Private
20	Investigator Act.
21	B. On or after November 1, 2022, a person employed or operating
22	as an unarmed security guard who has submitted a complete license
23	application to the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training
24	and who is employed by a licensed security agency shall have forty-

1	five (45) days from the date of employment to secure a license
2	issued by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training
3	pursuant to the Oklahoma Security Guard and Private Investigator
4	Act. If the application of the person is denied before forty-five
5	(45) days has expired or if the time expires prior to the issuance
6	of a license, the person shall not continue to operate as a security
7	guard until such time as a proper license is issued.
8	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
