An Act relating to county and municipal buildings; providing for the display of the national motto in certain county or municipal buildings; providing for the meaning of display; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2.1 of Title 19, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The governing body in a county or municipality in this state shall be authorized to display the national motto of the United States in a prominently visible location in any building in their respective custody. The placement and size of the display shall be in keeping with the placement and size of the display of the national motto in the United States Capitol Visitor Center.

B. The display of the national motto shall not be construed to mean that the county or municipality favors any particular religion or denomination thereof over others.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
