| 14 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: |
| 15 | SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 44 O.S. 2011, Section 235, is |
| 16 | amended to read as follows: |
| 17 | Section 235. There is hereby created the 45th Infantry Division |
| 18 | Oklahoma National Guard Museum, to be under the supervision of the |
| 19 | Adjutant General. The Adjutant General may appoint an Executive |
| 20 | Director to oversee the daily operations and maintenance of the |
| 21 | museum and perform other duties as requested by the Adjutant |
| 22 | General. Appropriate state agencies are directed to make available, |
| 23 | for display of items of historical significance and necessary space |
| 24 | for administration, the buildings presently occupied by the Oklahoma |

1 Military Department, located in the vicinity of 36th Street and 2 North Eastern in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. The building herein 3 referred to shall be made available by the Adjutant General as soon as same is no longer needed by and is vacated by the Oklahoma 5 Military Department. The Executive Director, subject to the approval of the Adjutant General, may lease to the 45th Infantry 6 Division Association, for periods not exceeding one (1) year and 7 with provisions for renewal from year to year, an area to be used as 9 a gift shop, if the lease does not interfere with its use by the 10 45th Infantry Division Oklahoma National Guard Museum. The proceeds 11 of the sales from the gift shop shall remain with the 45th Infantry 12 Division Association for operating purposes. SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 44 O.S. 2011, Section 235.1, as 13 amended by Section 156, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (44 O.S. Supp. 14 2020, Section 235.1), is amended to read as follows: 15 Section 235.1. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a 16 special fund to be known as the "45th Infantry Division Oklahoma 17 National Guard Museum Fund", which fund shall consist of donations 18 received for operation and maintenance of the museum and monies 19 received from the sale of Armed Forces Veterans Motorcycle License 20 Plates pursuant to Section 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma 21 Statutes. Said The fund shall be a continuing fund not subject to 22 fiscal year limitations and shall be under the administrative 23 direction of the Oklahoma Military Department. Expenditures from 24

- the fund created by this section shall be used exclusively for
 expenses of operation and maintenance of the 45th Infantry Division

 Oklahoma National Guard Museum and shall be made pursuant to the
 laws of this state and without legislative appropriation. Warrants
 for expenditures from said the fund shall be drawn by the State
 Treasurer, based on claims signed by an authorized employee of the
 department and approved for payment by the Director of the Office of
 Management and Enterprise Services.
- 9 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 44 O.S. 2011, Section 235.2, as
 10 amended by Section 157, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (44 O.S. Supp.
 11 2020, Section 235.2), is amended to read as follows:
 - Section 235.2. The Adjutant General of Oklahoma is hereby authorized to accept gifts for and on behalf of the state of military artifacts, military books and maps and materials, supplies and equipment which support the construction and operation of the museum which have been or may be specifically donated to the 45th Infantry Division Oklahoma National Guard Museum.

The Executive Director of the 45th Infantry Division Oklahoma

National Guard Museum is directed to maintain and preserve appropriate records for all such gifts made to the museum.

Upon declaring that certain military artifacts or military books and maps belonging to the 45th Infantry Division Oklahoma National

Guard Museum are surplus to the needs of the museum, the Executive Director of the 45th Infantry Division Oklahoma National Guard
