14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 50 O.S. 2011, Section 16, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 16. <u>A.</u> Cities and towns in this state shall have the
17	right and power to determine what is and what shall constitute a
18	nuisance within their respective corporate limits, and for the
19	protection of the public health, the public parks and the public
20	water supply, shall have such power outside of the corporate limits;
21	and wherever it is practical so to do, said <u>the</u> cities and towns
22	shall have the power summarily to abate any such nuisance after
23	notice to the owner, and an opportunity for him to be heard, if this
24	can be given. Any action conducted by critical infrastructure

1	sectors shall not constitute a nuisance when the applicable industry
2	acts in compliance with or acts consistently with government rules,
3	guidelines or laws applicable to their sector.
4	B. For purposes of this section, "critical infrastructure
5	sectors" means any of the critical infrastructure sectors identified
6	by the United States government whose assets, systems and networks,
7	whether physical or virtual, are considered so vital to the United
8	States and the state that the sectors' incapacitation or destruction
9	would have a debilitating effect on security, economic security,
10	public health or safety or any combination thereof.
11	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
