NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 862 of Title 47, unless there is 19 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 20 The Department of Public Safety shall promulgate rules and 21 regulations necessary to implement a vehicle emissions inspection 22 program that complies with established best practices including, but

not limited to, regulations as posted in the Federal Register.

The program shall require that:

- a. a vehicle passes an emissions inspection every two (2)
  years prior to renewing registration,
- b. a certificate or other documentation showing the vehicle identification number, date of last emissions inspection and whether the vehicle is in compliance with the provisions of this section and of the rules and regulations promulgated as prescribed in this section is provided to the vehicle owner at the time an inspection is completed,
- c. a vehicle owner maintains in the vehicle at all times an emissions inspection certificate demonstrating the vehicle is in compliance with the testing requirements promulgated according to the provisions of this section,
- d. all vehicles that require annual vehicle registration renewal participate including, but not limited to, passenger vehicles and light trucks,
- e. drivers present certification of the vehicle passing emissions inspection as a prerequisite to renewing registration,
- f. hybrid vehicles obtain an Onboard Diagnostic (OBD) emission inspection,
- g. electric vehicles are exempt from emissions inspection requirement, and

1	h. any person or entity selling a vehicle shall provide
2	the most recent emissions inspection report at the
3	time of sale;
4	2. The provisions of this section shall apply to vehicles older
5	than two (2) but not older than thirty (30) years old;
6	3. The provisions of this section shall be implemented by
7	January 1, 2024.
8	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
