16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:								
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 52 O.S. 2011, Section 288.5A, as								
18	amended by Section 2, Chapter 199, O.S.L. 2013 (52 O.S. Supp. 2020,								
19	Section 288.5A), is amended to read as follows:								
20	Section 288.5A. A. There is hereby created the Committee for								
21	Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources which shall be under the								
22	direction and supervision of the Oklahoma Energy Resources Board and								
23	shall be operate for the purpose of encouraging new processes or								
24 27	technological advancements to sustain the oil and natural gas								

¹ industry in the future for the benefit of the citizens of this state ² and for advancing activities to support marginally producing oil and ³ gas wells.

4 в. 1. The Committee for Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources 5 shall be made up of not less than twelve but not more than eighteen 6 members. The Oklahoma Energy Resources Board Committee shall select 7 one member of the Board to serve as the chair of the Committee. 8 Except as otherwise provided, members of the Committee shall be 9 appointed by the chair of the Committee and approved by a majority 10 of the Board.

11 2. The Secretary of Energy or a designee shall serve as a 12 member of the Committee for Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources. 13 The Secretary of Energy shall select one member of the Committee who 14 shall currently be serving on the Oklahoma Energy Initiative Board 15 on behalf of the University of Oklahoma, Oklahoma State University, 16 the University of Tulsa or Oklahoma City University.

17 3. Of the remaining members of the Committee for Sustaining
 18 Oklahoma's Energy Resources at least:

19a.four members shall be independent oil and gas20operators, of which at least one shall be from each of21the four Corporation Commission regulatory districts22as they existed on January 1, 2013, and each shall23have operations in the district they represent,

- b. one member shall be an independent oil and gas operator from Osage County and shall have operations in Osage County,
- c. one member shall be an independent oil and gas
 operator selected from a list of operators submitted
 by the Oklahoma Independent Petroleum Association,
 d. one member shall be an oil and gas operator selected
 from a list of operators submitted by the MidContinent Oil and Gas Association,
- e. one member shall be an Oklahoma oil and gas royalty
 owner selected from a list of names submitted by the
 Oklahoma Mineral Owners Association, and
- 13 f. one member shall be an Oklahoma oil and gas royalty 14 owner selected from a list of names submitted by the 15 Oklahoma affiliate of the National Association of 16 Royalty Owners.

17 4. With the exception of the Secretary of Energy or the 18 designee of the Secretary, Committee members shall serve for three-19 year terms and may be removed from the Committee by a majority vote 20 of the Committee with or without cause. The Oklahoma Energy 21 Resources Board Committee may establish any additional 22 qualifications, requirements or conditions it deems appropriate for 23 members of the Committee which are consistent with the provisions of 24 this section. The chair of the Committee, with the approval of the _ _

Board, shall strive to select representatives of all facets of the oil and natural gas industry, and the University of Oklahoma, Oklahoma State University, the University of Tulsa, and Oklahoma City University, in addition to any other interested higher education institutions and governmental entities charged with duties and authority over relevant areas.

5. No member of the Committee shall receive a salary for duties
performed as a member of the Committee; however, members may be
eligible to receive reimbursement for necessary and actual travel
expenses as provided for in the State Travel Reimbursement Act if
approved by the Oklahoma Energy Resources Board.

12 6. Members appointed to serve on the Committee shall be 13 eligible to serve on any other state board or commission if the 14 member is otherwise qualified to hold such appointed office, 15 notwithstanding the provisions of Section 6 of Title 51 of the 16 Oklahoma Statutes.

C. The Committee for Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources is authorized to accept appropriations, donations, grants, contributions and gifts from any public or private source for the purpose of implementing the provisions of this act Section 288.1 et <u>seq. of this title</u>. The Committee shall deposit such funds in the revolving fund created in Section 288.5B of this title.

D. The Committee for Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources, with the advice and consent of the Oklahoma Energy Resources Board, ¹ is authorized to promulgate rules as necessary to implement the ² provisions of this act the Oklahoma Energy Education and Marketing ³ Act.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 199, O.S.L.
2013 (52 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 288.5C), is amended to read as
follows:

Section 288.5C. A. Effective July 1, 2013, all duties, assets and obligations of the Commission on Marginally Producing Oil and Gas Wells created pursuant to Section 700 of Title 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be transferred to the authority of the Committee for Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources created pursuant to Section 288.5A of Title 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

B. Effective July 1, 2013, the terms of the members of the Commission on Marginally Producing Oil and Gas Wells appointed pursuant to the provisions of Section 700 of Title 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be terminated.

C. Effective July 1, 2013, all unclassified full-time equivalent, part-time, and temporary employees of the Commission on
 Marginally Producing Oil and Gas Wells shall be terminated.
 Employees shall be paid for any accrued annual leave and may be
 eligible for other benefits as provided by law.

D. Activities and functions previously performed by the
 Commission on Marginally Producing Oil and Gas Wells shall be under
 the responsibility of the Committee for Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy

1 Resources or a successor committee as provided by law. The 2 Committee may organize itself, create subcommittees or adopt 3 procedures as deemed necessary and appropriate and consistent with 4 the provisions of this act the Oklahoma Energy Education and 5 Marketing Act to implement the provisions of this act and carry out 6 the functions and duties of the Commission on Marginally Producing 7 Oil and Gas Wells with the exception of making annual reports as 8 required by paragraph 7 of subsection A of Section 701 of Title 52 9 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

E. Monies remaining in the Commission on Marginally Producing Oil and Gas Wells Revolving Fund created in Section 705 of Title 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be transferred to the credit of the Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources Revolving Fund created in Section 288.5B of Title 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes for use as provided in this act the Oklahoma Energy Education and Marketing Act.

17 F. The Committee for Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources 18 with the advice and consent of the Oklahoma Energy Resources Board 19 is authorized to promulgate any rules necessary to implement the 20 provisions of this act the Oklahoma Energy Education and Marketing 21 The Secretary of Energy may provide assistance as necessary to Act. 22 oversee the transfer of duties, assets and obligations pursuant to 23 this act Section 288.1 et seq. of this title.
