12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840-2.20D of Title 74, unless
14	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	A. An appointing authority may grant COVID-19 sick leave with
16	pay not to exceed fifteen (15) working days per state fiscal year to
17	a state employee who is affected by COVID-19 or a variant thereof in
18	Oklahoma if:
19	1. The employee works in a healthcare or full-time custodial
20	care facility operated by this state;
21	2. The employee is required to isolate or quarantine because
22	the employee or a member of the employee's household tests positive
23	for COVID-19 or a variant thereof; or

1	3. The employee has insufficient leave balances to continue in
2	a paid leave status for the duration of the period of quarantine
3	required by agency policy.
4	B. Leave granted under this section shall be in such amounts
5	necessary to supplement the use of the employee's paid leave after
6	depletion of all available leave balances in order to avoid a leave
7	without pay status.
8	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
10	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
