SENATE BILL 1197

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to Corporation Commission; amending 17 O.S. 2021, Section 304, which relates to exemptions for the Oklahoma Petroleum Storage Tank Consolidation Act; exempting hydrogen tank systems from certain provisions; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 17 O.S. 2021, Section 304, is amended to read as follows:

Section 304. The provisions of the Oklahoma Petroleum Storage Tank Consolidation Act shall not apply to:

1. Septic tank systems;
2. Pipeline facilities;
3. Surface impoundments, pits, ponds or lagoons;
4. Stormwater and wastewater collection systems;
5. Flow-through process tank systems;
6. Liquid trap or associated gathering lines directly related to oil or gas production and gathering operations;
7. Hydraulic lift tank systems;

1        8. Hydrogen storage tank systems;

2        ~~8.~~ 9. Storage tank systems with a capacity of less than one  
3 hundred ten (110) gallons;

4        ~~9.~~ 10. Fleet and commercial aboveground storage tanks with an  
5 individual capacity of two thousand one hundred (2,100) gallons or  
6 less;

7        ~~10.~~ 11. Storage tank systems with a de minimus concentration of  
8 regulated substances;

9        ~~11.~~ 12. Storage tank systems that serve as emergency backup  
10 tanks, provided that such backup tanks hold regulated substances for  
11 only a short period of time and are expeditiously emptied after each  
12 use. The provisions of this paragraph shall not prevent Corporation  
13 Commission notification requirements and such other restrictions as  
14 may be deemed necessary by the Commission to protect the  
15 environment;

16        ~~12.~~ 13. Farm or residential underground storage tanks with an  
17 individual capacity of one thousand one hundred (1,100) gallons or  
18 less used for noncommercial purposes;

19        ~~13.~~ 14. Underground storage tanks used for storing heating oil  
20 for consumptive use on the premises where stored;

21        ~~14.~~ 15. Storage tank systems storing hazardous wastes regulated  
22 under Subtitle C of the federal Solid Waste Disposal Act, 42 U.S.C.,  
23 Section 6921 et seq., or substances regulated as hazardous wastes  
24 under the Oklahoma Hazardous Waste Management Act; and

1       ~~15.~~ 16. Fuel storage facilities and associated equipment used  
2 in wholesale or bulk distribution activities that are supplied by a  
3 pipeline and from which fuel may be removed at a rack.

4       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.

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
