SENATE BILL 1209

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; directing a member of a board of education of a school district or technology center school district to be removed from office if he or she votes in favor of certain violation; providing for filling of vacancy; prohibiting member subject to certain provisions from serving in certain position for certain period of time; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-107C of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Upon the effective date of this act, if a member or prospective member of a school district board of education or a technology center school district board of education has voted or votes in favor of knowingly violating any state law relevant to public education or within Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the member or prospective member shall not be qualified to serve in the position. The school district board of education or technology center school

1 district board of education shall declare the seat of the member
2 vacant, and the vacancy shall be filled as provided for in Section
3 13A-110 of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The member or
4 prospective member shall be prohibited from serving in any role,
5 paid or unpaid, for public schools in this state for a period of
6 five (5) years.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

8 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
