15	six (6) persons, five who shall be licensed as pharmacists by this
16	state and one who shall be a public member.
17	1. The pharmacist members shall be appointed by the Governor by
18	and with the advice and consent of the Senate and shall:
19	a. be registered and in good standing in <del>the State of</del>
20	<del>Oklahoma</del> this state, and
21	b. have been actively engaged in the practice of pharmacy
22	within this state for a period of not less than five
23	(5) years immediately prior to serving on the Board.

- a. be a resident of the State of Oklahoma this state for not less than five (5) years, and
- b. not be a pharmacist or be related by blood or marriage within the third degree of consanguinity to a pharmacist.

8 В. The present members of the Board shall be appointed for a 9 term of five (5) years. The public member of the Board shall serve 10 a term coterminous with the Governor and shall serve at the pleasure 11 of the Governor. The terms of the members of the Board shall expire 12 on the 30th day of June of the year designated for the expiration of 13 the term for which appointed but the member shall serve until a 14 qualified successor has been duly appointed. No person shall be 15 appointed to serve more than two consecutive terms. Appointments of 16 pharmacists to the Board shall be made from a list of ten (10) names 17 representative of the pharmacy profession submitted annually by the 18 Executive Director of the Oklahoma Pharmacists Association after an 19 election has been held by mail ballot.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
