14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1020.1 of Title 56, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. Upon completion of an assessment of individuals receiving
18	home- and community-based services for individuals with intellectual
19	disabilities or of individuals waiting to receive home- and
20	community-based services for individuals with intellectual
21	disabilities, the Department of Human Services shall compile a final
22	report of the following information and publish monthly updates of
23	such information on the Department's Internet website:
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1 1. Demographic information on individuals waiting to receive 2 home- and community-based services for individuals with intellectual 3 disabilities including but not limited to age, gender, location, and 4 whether or not they are currently receiving benefits or supports 5 including but not limited to Medicaid, the Supplemental Nutrition 6 Assistance Program (SNAP), Temporary Assistance for Needy Families 7 (TANF), and other major state or federal assistance programs; 8 2. The number of applicants who began receiving or stopped 9 receiving home- and community-based services for individuals with 10 intellectual disabilities during the assessment period and the 11 reason services were stopped; 12 3. Any relevant trends in data relating to individuals waiting 13 to receive home and community based services; 14 4. The frequency of contact between the Department and 15 applicants and the mode of contact; 16 5. Resource gaps by type and by geographic area; and 17 6. Resource or community supports and resources in need of 18 expansion. 19 The final report shall be published on the Department's Β. 20 website and submitted to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and 21 the Speaker of the House of Representatives. 22 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 23 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 24 _ _
