1 2. Add ten (10) additional sales and use tax audit and/or 2 enforcement personnel as soon as practicable after July 1, 2011. 3 B. For the purposes of this section: 4 1. "Teleconferencing" means a conference among members of the 5 Commission and members of the public remote from one another who are 6 linked by telecommunication devices and/or technology permitting 7 auditory communication between and among members of the Commission 8 and/or between and among members of the Commission and members of 9 the public; and 10 2. "Videoconferencing" means a conference among members of the 11 Commission and members of the public remote from one another who are 12 linked by interactive telecommunication devices or technology and/or 13 technology permitting both visual and auditory communication between 14 and among members of the Commission and/or between and among members 15 of the Commission and members of the public. During any 16 videoconference, both the visual and auditory communications 17 functions shall attempt to be utilized. 18 SECTION 2.
