6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to medical treatment; prohibiting  
8 state entity or political subdivision from compelling  
9 any medical procedure, use of medical device or  
10 wearing of face covering; providing offense; defining  
11 term; providing for codification; and declaring an  
12 emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3170 of Title 63, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no state entity or  
18 political subdivision of this state shall, through direct or  
19 indirect means, compel or coerce any person under its jurisdiction  
20 to undergo any unwanted medical procedure including, but not limited  
21 to, an immunization, to use any unwanted medical device, or to wear  
22 any face covering. A person who violates this section shall be  
23 guilty of a misdemeanor. As used in this section, "political  
24 subdivision" means a county, city, town, school district, or other  
25 local governmental or public entity located within this state.

1           SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
2 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
