6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to municipal courts; requiring
8 Supreme Court to establish Municipal Court Disclosure
9 System pilot program; establishing requirements for
10 pilot program; providing for optional participation
11 by municipal courts in certain counties; authorizing
12 assessment of certain fee; authorizing third party
13 contract for certain purpose; requiring Supreme Court
14 to consider certain input; providing for
15 codification; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 27-133 of Title 11, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 The Oklahoma Supreme Court shall establish a Municipal Court
21 Disclosure System pilot program to create a court records disclosure
22 system similar to the Oklahoma On Demand Court Records system
23 utilized by tribal and district courts in this state. The pilot
24 program shall consist of municipal courts located within a single
county in this state. Any municipal court in the county of the
pilot program shall have the option to participate in the disclosure

1 system during the pilot period. During the pilot period, municipal
2 courts may assess up to a Five Dollar (\$5.00) public disclosure fee
3 to be added to all convictions with the fee used to offset the
4 collection, dissemination, and costs associated with the inputting
5 of conviction data into the system developed by the Oklahoma Supreme
6 Court. Municipal governments with a municipal court may contract
7 with a third party to collect, disseminate, or input conviction data
8 into the system developed by the Supreme Court as outlined in this
9 subsection. The Oklahoma Supreme Court shall consider input
10 provided by a representative from the Oklahoma Municipal Judge's
11 Association while implementing the provisions of this subsection.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
