13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2021, Section 85.17A, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 85.17A. A. State agencies shall not discriminate
16	against bidders from states or nations outside Oklahoma, except as
17	provided by this section. State agencies shall reciprocate the
18	bidding preference given by other states or nations to bidders
19	domiciled in their jurisdictions for acquisitions pursuant to the
20	Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act. The Purchasing Division shall
21	provide to certified procurement officers information regarding the
22	reciprocity provided by other states. This information shall be
23	used by state agencies in evaluating bids.
24 27	B. For purposes of awarding contracts state agencies shall:

1 1. Give preference to goods and services that have been 2 manufactured or produced in this state if the price, fitness, 3 availability and quality are otherwise equal; 4 2. Give preference to goods and services from another state 5 over foreign goods or services if goods or services manufactured or 6 produced in this state are not equal in price, fitness, availability 7 or quality; and 8 3. Give preference to goods and services provided by bidders 9 that have at least seventy-five percent (75%) of their total work 10 force located within this state; and 11 3. 4. Add a percent increase to the bid of a nonresident bidder 12 equal to the percent, if any, of the preference given to the bidder 13 in the state in which the bidder resides. 14 C. State agencies shall provide an explanation to any bidder 15 that is domiciled in this state as to why a bid that was submitted 16 was not accepted. 17 SECTION 2.
