15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 14 O.S. 2021, Section 80.8, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 80.8. To file as a candidate for the State Senate in
18	any senatorial district, a person must have been a registered voter
19	in the district and a resident residing within such district for the
20	six-month period immediately preceding the first day of the filing
21	period as provided by law. Provided, however, to file as a
22	candidate for the Senate in any Senate district in 2022, a person
23	must have been a registered voter and a resident residing in such

district no later than $\frac{\text{December 31, 2021}}{\text{October 12, 2021}}$. Any

member of the Senate whose district has been changed by a redistricting may change residence with the intent of becoming qualified to seek reelection in such district in the first election applicable to such district following redistricting without thereby being deemed to have vacated his or her existing office. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022. SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval. 58-2-2590 CР 1/19/2022 1:33:23 PM
