17	A. Upon the effective date of this act, the Department of
18	Public Safety shall query the Electronic Verification of Vital
19	Events (EVVE) system prior to issuance of a new driver license
20	application or state-issued identification, a renewal of a driver
21	license or state-issued identification, or an application for a lost
22	or destroyed driver license or a state-issued identification card.
23	In the event that the EVVE system is unable to verify the original
24 47	or certified birth certificate copy presented for any reason, EVVE

1	shall provide a question-and-answer-based verification process that
2	with near certainty, can establish the validity of the professed
3	identity of applicants.
4	B. The Department of Public Safety shall promulgate rules for
5	the provisions provided for in this section.
6	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
