SENATE BILL 1557

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to licenses; requiring the Department of Public Safety to query the Electronic Verification of Vital Events (EVVE) system under certain conditions; requiring EVVE to provide a question-and-answer-based verification process under certain conditions; requiring the Department of Public Safety to promulgate certain rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-110.6 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Upon the effective date of this act, the Department of Public Safety shall query the Electronic Verification of Vital Events (EVVE) system prior to issuance of a new driver license application or state-issued identification, a renewal of a driver license or state-issued identification, or an application for a lost or destroyed driver license or a state-issued identification card. In the event that the EVVE system is unable to verify the original or certified birth certificate copy presented for any reason, EVVE

1 shall provide a question-and-answer-based verification process that  
2 with near certainty, can establish the validity of the professed  
3 identity of applicants.

4 B. The Department of Public Safety shall promulgate rules for  
5 the provisions provided for in this section.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
