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11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 51 O.S. 2021, Section 24A.3, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 24A.3. As used in the Oklahoma Open Records Act:
15	1. "Record" means all documents $_{ au}$ including, but not limited to,
16	any book, paper, photograph, microfilm, data files created by or
17	used with computer software, computer tape, disk, record, sound
18	recording, film recording, video record or other material regardless
19	of physical form or characteristic, created by, received by, under
20	the authority of, or coming into the custody, control or possession
21	of public officials, public bodies, or their representatives in
22	connection with the transaction of public business, the expenditure
23	of public funds or the administering of public property. "Record"
24	does not mean:

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- a. computer software,
- b. nongovernment personal effects,
- c. unless public disclosure is required by other laws or regulations, vehicle movement records of the Oklahoma Transportation Authority obtained in connection with the Authority's electronic toll collection system,
- d. personal financial information, credit reports or other financial data obtained by or submitted to a public body for the purpose of evaluating credit worthiness, obtaining a license, permit, or for the purpose of becoming qualified to contract with a public body,
- e. any digital audio/video recordings of the toll
   collection and safeguarding activities of the Oklahoma
   Transportation Authority,
- 16 f. any personal information provided by a guest at any 17 facility owned or operated by the Oklahoma Tourism and 18 Recreation Department or the Board of Trustees of the 19 Quartz Mountain Arts and Conference Center and Nature 20 Park to obtain any service at the facility or by a 21 purchaser of a product sold by or through the Oklahoma 22 Tourism and Recreation Department or the Quartz 23 Mountain Arts and Conference Center and Nature Park,
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   g. a Department of Defense Form 214 (DD Form 214) filed

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   with a county clerk, including any DD Form 214 filed

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   before July 1, 2002, or
- h. except as provided for in Section 2-110 of Title 47 of
  the Oklahoma Statutes,
- 6 (1) any record in connection with a Motor Vehicle
  7 Report issued by the Department of Public Safety,
  8 as prescribed in Section 6-117 of Title 47 of the
  9 Oklahoma Statutes, or
- 10 (2) personal information within driver records, as 11 defined by the Driver's Privacy Protection Act, 12 18 United States Code, Sections 2721 through 13 2725, which are stored and maintained by the 14 Department of Public Safety;

"Public body" shall include, but not be limited to, any 16 office, department, board, bureau, commission, agency, trusteeship, 17 authority, council, committee, trust or any entity created by a 18 trust, county, city, village, town, township, district, school 19 district, fair board, court, executive office, advisory group, task 20 force, study group, or any subdivision thereof, supported in whole 21 or in part by public funds or entrusted with the expenditure of 22 public funds or administering or operating public property, and all 23 committees, or subcommittees thereof. Except for the records 24 required by Section 24A.4 of this title, "public body" does not mean \_ \_

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1	judges, justices, the Council on Judicial Complaints, the
2	Legislature, or legislators. "Public body" shall not include an
3	organization that is exempt from federal income tax under Section
4	501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and
5	whose sole beneficiary is a college or university that is a member
6	of The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education. Such organization
7	shall not receive direct appropriations from the Oklahoma
8	Legislature. The following persons shall not be eligible to serve
9	as a trustee, director, or officer of the organization:
10	a. a member, officer, or employee of the Oklahoma State
11	Regents for Higher Education,
12	b. a member of the board of regents or other governing
13	board of the college or university that is the sole
14	beneficiary of the organization, or
15	<u>c.</u> an officer or employee of the college or university
16	that is the sole beneficiary of the organization;
17	3. "Public office" means the physical location where public
18	bodies conduct business or keep records;
19	4. "Public official" means any official or employee of any
20	public body as defined herein; and
21	5. "Law enforcement agency" means any public body charged with
22	enforcing state or local criminal laws and initiating criminal
23	prosecutions, including, but not limited to, police departments,
24 23	county sheriffs, the Department of Public Safety, the Oklahoma State

1	Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control, the Alcoholic
2	Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission, and the Oklahoma State Bureau
3	of Investigation.
4	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
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
