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11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2021, Section 6004, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 6004. The Tax Commission shall require every person
15	licensed as a dealer in aircraft pursuant to the provisions of
16	Sections 251 through 257 of Title 3 of the Oklahoma Statutes to make
17	a report to the Tax Commission within a period of thirty (30) days
18	after the transfer by such person of the legal ownership of any
19	aircraft. The report shall be made on a form prescribed and
20	furnished by the Tax Commission, showing the name and address of the
21	purchaser, a description of the aircraft $_{ au}$ including the name of the
22	manufacturer, the Federal Aviation Administration registration
23	number of the aircraft, the type and year manufactured, the serial
24	number, the date of the transfer, whether the aircraft is exempt
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1	from the aircraft excise tax pursuant to Section 6003 of this title,
2	and the amount of the sale price. The Tax Commission may cancel or
3	suspend the license of any person licensed as a dealer in aircraft
4	pursuant to the provisions of Sections 251 through 257 of Title 3 of
5	the Oklahoma Statutes who shall fail or refuse to comply with the
6	provisions of Sections $\frac{2}{6001}$ through $\frac{8}{6007}$ of this act title.
7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
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
