12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 44 O.S. 2021, Section 242, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 242. <u>A.</u> Such military forces shall be designated as
16	the "Oklahoma State Guard" and shall be composed of officers
17	commissioned or assigned, and such able-bodied male citizens of the
18	state as shall volunteer for service therein. They shall be
19	additional to and distinct from the National Guard of the State of
20	Oklahoma, as defined in Title 32 of the United States Code. They
21	shall not be required to serve outside the boundaries of the State
22	of Oklahoma.
23	B. If, for any reason, the Department of Defense removes
24	national recognition from the Oklahoma National Guard, all

1	resources, officers, employees, positions, and funds shall be
2	transferred immediately to the Oklahoma State Guard.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
