SENATE BILL 1822

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public finance; stating
Legislative intent; requiring signage be placed on
certain federally funded projects; providing for
codification; providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.701 of Title 62, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Legislature finds that the Works Projects Administration
(WPA) was instrumental in the development of the United States of
America. Projects completed by the WPA improved the infrastructure
and culture of those cities for decades, allowing the United States
to thrive after World War II and continue to stand the test of time
today. Upon the completion of each project, a plaque was mounted in
plain view to let the public know the project was constructed for
the people of that community. It is the intent of the Legislature
to do the same, with all infrastructure or construction projects in
this state that are funded partially or fully by the American Rescue

1 Plan Act of 2021 or the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act of
2 2021.

3 B. All infrastructure or construction projects in this state
4 that are funded partially or fully by the American Rescue Plan Act
5 of 2021 or the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act of 2021, shall
6 have signage displayed in a prominently visible location at the
7 project site. The signage shall state the funding source and year
8 completed. The Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department shall
9 oversee the design and placement of signage on each project.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
