SENATE BILL 1837

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to alcoholic beverages; allowing for the holder of certain licenses to operate on the same premises; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 102.2 of Title 37A, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A holder of a brewer license pursuant to Section 2-102 of Title 37A of the Oklahoma Statutes who also holds a winemaker license pursuant to Section 2-104 of Title 37A of the Oklahoma Statutes may operate a brewery and winery on the same premises.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
